Historic milestones:

- 1874 – Robert Schindler founds the company.
- 1909 – Schindler introduces first variable-speed electric elevators.
- 1929 – Westinghouse installs first operator-free elevator.
- 1940 – Westinghouse installs deck-edge elevators on aircraft carriers, which can transport airplanes to the flight deck in a matter of seconds.
- 1952 – Schindler introduces first electronic elevator controls.
- 1961 – Schindler introduces first solid-state elevator controls.
- 1979 – Schindler acquires Houghton Elevator Company.
- 1980 – Schindler pioneers microprocessor elevator technology.
- 1989 – Schindler acquires Westinghouse Electric Corporation's elevator and escalator business and quadruples its presence in North America.
- 1989 – Millar Elevator Service Company, the first nationwide company devoted to service and modernization, formed.
- 1996 – Revolutionary Miconic 10 elevator system launched.
- 2000 – Schindler introduces first fully synthetic elevator rope, Aramid[®].
- 2002 – Schindler and Millar consolidate operations.
- 2004 – Center for Service Excellence established in Holland, Ohio (national service support center)
- 2005 – Service Logistics Center established in Niles, Illinois (national service parts and logistics center)
